


## ISD 318 BACK TO SCHOOL HEALTH REMINDERS

2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

- 1 Hang our Daily Health Check on your fridge and go over it with your child every morning.
- 2 Masks are strongly recommended in our buildings and are <u>required</u> on all school buses.
- If someone in your household is getting tested for COVID because they are symptomatic or were exposed, your student(s) should stay home until the results are verified. If the test is negative and the students are not ill or showing symptoms, they may return to school.
- If a family member in the same household tests positive while a student is still at school, the student will be considered to have a probable case unless they are vaccinated. A parent or guardian will be called to pick up your child.
- Students with a family member who has tested positive must be quarantined for 14 days from the last day of exposure unless they have been vaccinated.
- Do your part. Sending sick kids to school could result in enhanced mitigation measures including masks and/or additional quarantines.
